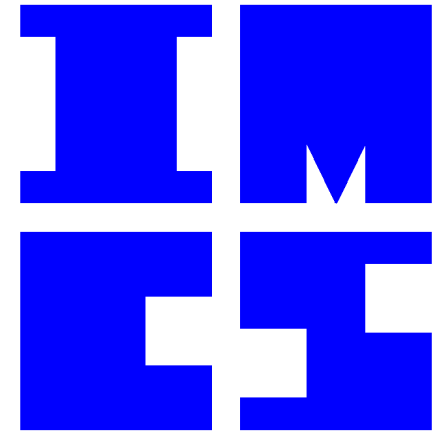

The decision to create the International Mediterranean & Latin American Council of Simulation in order to establish a Modeling & Simulation reference was supported by a rationale that justified the institution of a Mediterranean network.

In fact our proposal was based on the existing situation in Europe, Mediterranean and Latin America even considering feedback, indications as well as requests from the scientific simulation community.

We consider our responsibility and duty to represent the potential of simulation in this area and to promote I-M-CS. This Simulation Networking Initiative was motivated by the need to guarantee that an extended scientific community, such as the Mediterranean and Latin American Cultural Area (South Europe, South America, North Africa), were properly represented and active at an international level. This action was helpful to avoid any unbalanced clustering and concentration of the activities that extend over a much wider context into some restricted areas.

In fact the role of Mediterranean and Latin American Cultural Countries in the simulation research and development sector was defined along with actions to ensure that the I-M-CS will remain as permanent Institution and not just as a temporary initiative. In effect, modern computer simulation has been developed mainly in the Anglo-Saxon environment, and therefore we also want to contribute to the definition and development of modern M&S.

Since middle of '90 the Mediterranean Simulation Excellence Centers have been developing innovative projects, acting as major contributors in the worldwide scenario. International events in these areas were a real success as they attracted the world community through the presentation of extensive and outstanding regional activities while proposing new developments.

Based on such considerations in 2002, we decided to overcome the vagueness of the current panorama, where everything is defined as useful and correct, while in reality no new projects or long-term strategies are focusing on our geographical areas. Our feeling was based on the awareness of our current expertise and cultural roots, in which sites, times and historical events are combined in a complex matrix worthy of further analysis: historical Mediterranean episodes are sometimes more famous for their cultural impact than the events themselves, and evidence has shown that simulation issues were being addressed even in the ancient past.

As result of these actions, I-M-CS was established as Regional Council of the International Society for Modeling & Simulation (ISCS) since 2004.

Among first step the I-M-CS has taken charge of organizing the European Fall Conference (European Modeling & Simulation Conference) in conjunction with other classical events such as: MAS and IMAACA; in the same years HMS Conference was organized in Brazil to promote Simulation among Latin American Communities.

WAMS: A Classic International Workshop

The 10th WAMS concentrates on Applications of Simulation and Computer Technologies. The new 10th edition in 2017 will result another great opportunity for the International Simulation Community to meet together in the beautiful framework of Florence. In fact, WAMS is a workshop very effective in networking and very useful to set up new proposals and projects. Worldwide specialists have the opportunity to participate and to interact within this important International Forum on Applied M&S. The audience will include both users, vendors and scientists operating in applying advanced techniques to the main application areas and sectors including Industry, Business, Logistics Environment, Services & Defense. WAMS started as a series of international workshops organized in Latin America, [AMS2004](#) (Rio de Janeiro) and [AMS2006](#) (Buzios); these events were focusing on Application and Theory of Modeling & Simulation. In the following years, WAMS was organized in both side of Atlantic Ocean (i.e. Rio de Janeiro, Italian Riviera), while in 2011, WAMS was co-located with the [International Marine Defense Show in St.Petersburg Russia](#) organized in Joint Cooperation with [SPIIRAS Russian Academy of Science](#). In 2012, WAMS was held in Rome in connections with the [NATO CAX Forum](#). The [WAMS 2013](#) was back in Latin America and it attracted scientists, technicians and experts from world leading Universities, Institutions, Agencies and Companies; indeed WAMS 2013 edition was held in [Buenos Aires, Argentina](#) and was attended by all Latin America Countries as well as by scientists from Europe, North America, Asia and Australia.

In 2014, WAMS moved in the wonderful framework of the Bosphorous (Istanbul, Turkey) in co-location with the [NATO CAX Forum](#). Therefore WAMS returned in Italy in 2015 ([Bergggi](#)) and 2016 ([Cagliari](#)). In 2017 WAMS is co-located again with [NATO CAX Forum](#) in Florence.
